Executive Summary



Result of the actions & measures -Workshop

A lot of preliminary work has already been done in the course of the roadmap development process. Starting with a mapping of the region in spring 2020, a vision-Workshop at the end of October 2020, four round-table-discussions in spring 2021 and a web-based development-Workshop on April facts, data, information and goals were collected together with representatives of the region.

Approximately 100 detailed goals were developed from the vision and summarized into 35 main goal directions. To ensure that these goals can be achieved in five years, the task at the action & measures -Workshop was to develop future activities.

This was done in five moderated small groups. Stakeholder representatives from science, business, the public sector and society have been invited to participate in the workshop.

38 attendees accepted this invitation and actively participated in the actions & measures-Workshop on June 30, 2011. After introducing presentations, working groups were formed to develop and discuss the actions in small groups.

Each of these small groups was assigned 10 main target directions. Each participant was able to contribute suggestions individually, which were then discussed and deepened together in the group. The main criteria for evaluating the measures was the commitment of the stakeholders to get involved in the action plan.

The discussion revealed that many of the ideas for measures were supported by several participants and were considered extremely important for the transition to a digital region. The high level of commitment of the participants resulted in 47 measures. These were presented by the moderators in the plenary session and then discussed.
